**2022-2023 NEW STUDENTS | Full-Time Undergraduate Tuition and Related Charges**

Full-time undergraduate student tuition is a flat rate of \$19,463 per semester (traditional students enrolled in 12-21 credit hours). An overload fee of \$1,094 is assessed for each credit hour over twenty-one. This overload fee will apply to Music, Honor and Theater students above 23 hours.

4 All students living in the residence halls are required to participate in a meal plan.

**OTHER COSTS**

- Students have the option to purchase a Parking Permit, which allows safe, convenient, on-campus parking.
- Books, supplies and transportation costs vary. Please consider all costs related to your education, including costs not charged directly through your student account.
- Depending on your chosen field of study, you may have fees associated with your major or courses. For example, natural science majors are likely to be charged lab fees.
- Loyola provides optional insurance plans; a student health insurance plan for US citizens, a tuition refund insurance plan, and a renter insurance plan all supplied and managed by outside vendors.
